Normally an estimated 650,000 people travel by the metro everyday. But all through this month, the rider ship hovered around 750,000.

With the increase in commuters, the revenue collected by DMRC has also shot up.

"On an average A recording of an extra 50,000 footfalls per day in the metro, mostly along the Rajiv Chowk-Delhi University line. This has resulted in revenue being pushed up by Rs.1-2 million per day,"
